

Math 102 Activity for Math and the Visual Arts

Choose a group of three people and pick a window (with my help) on the second floor of Magale.

One person is the Art Director. This person should stand or sit facing the window with one eye closed. It is crucial that this person does not change her stance or move her head - so the Art Director should pick a spot where they can be comfortable for 30-40 minutes. The Art Director should have within her view major architectural details of Magale, Hamilton, Mickle, or the music school.

The other two people are the Artists. Following the guidance of the Art Director, they should place masking tape on the window. This masking tape should outline the major architectural details of the buildings as the Art Director sees them. Try to focus on walls that are parallel or perpendicular to your window, and then focus on rooflines, windows, columns, and doors.
